- S.R.O. No. 109-Law/2025—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Police Act, 1861 (Act. No. V of 1861), the Inspector-General of Police, with the approval of the Government, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:-
 - **1. Short title.**—This rules may be called the Police Dress Rules, 2025.
- 2. Override to other rules, regulations or orders.—The provisions of this rules shall have effect notwithstanding anything inconsistent therewith contained in any other rules, regulations or orders for the time being in force.
- 3. Police Monogram/ Logo: National flower Shapla (water lily), resting on water, surrounded by wheat and paddy wreath jointed by three jute leaves at the top, the word "Police" in Bengali shall be written below the lower joint of paddy and wheat wreath.
- **4. Working dress:** The working dress (in office and on field duties) shall be as follows:—
 - (1) **Headdress**: The Headdress shall be as follows:—

- (a) Peak-Cap and Blue Beret: Peak-cap of dark blue cloth with three cloth welts $4\frac{1}{4}$ inches total depth, diameter across the top $10\frac{3}{8}$ inches for a cap fitting $21\frac{3}{4}$ inches circumference, the top to be $\frac{1}{8}$ inch larger or smaller in diameter for every $\frac{1}{4}$ inch by which the cap may vary in size of head above or below the before mentioned standard. The sides to be made in four pieces and to be $2\frac{1}{8}$ inches deep between the welts. The peak of the cap will be of the following pattern:
 - (i) For Inspector-General of Police and Additional Inspector-General of Police: Patent leather, embroidered all round with oak leaf silver embroidery depth in the middle measuring two inches. To drop at an angle of 45 degrees.

The cap badge will be in silver embroidery on dark blue cloth, crossed sword and baton surrounded by paddy and wheat wreath. A shapla flower is placed on the centre top of crossed sword and baton.

- (ii) For Deputy Inspector-General of Police: As for Inspector General of Police but embroidered on front edge only. Cap badge will be in silver embroidery on dark blue cloth, one four pointed star surrounded by paddy and wheat wreath.
- (iii) For Additional DIG of Police: Similar to that of Deputy Inspector General of Police.
- (iv) For Superintendent of Police over 20 years of qualifying service as class-I officer: Similar to that of Deputy Inspector General of Police.
- (v) For Superintendent of Police: Plain or Leather Peak-Cap with silver embroidery of oak leaf on front edge. The cap badge will be one shapla with 3 jute leaves at the top surrounded by wheat and paddy wreath in silver embroidery.

- (vi) For Additional Superintendent of Police, Assistant Superintendent of Police: Similar to that of Superintendent of Police, but on front edge of the peak will be silver embroidery of Jute leaf.
- (vii) For Inspector: Plain/leather Peak Cap. The cap badge will be: One Shapla with 3 jute leaves at the top surrounded by wheat and paddy wreath in silver embroidery.

(b) Blue Beret:

- (i) For Inspector-General of Police and Additional Inspector-General of Police: Blue beret shall be of wool with black ribbon nylon head band and plastic board flap. The cap badge will be in silver embroidery on dark blue cloth, crossed sword and baton surrounded by paddy and wheat wreath. A shapla flower is placed on the centre top of crossed sword and baton.
- (ii) For Deputy Inspector-General, Addl. Deputy Inspector-General and Superintendent of Police over 20 years of qualifying service as class-I officer: Blue beret shall be of wool with black ribbon nylon head band and plastic board flap. Cap badge will be in silver embroidery on dark blue cloth, one four pointed star surrounded by paddy and wheat wreath.
- (iii) For Superintendent of Police, Additional Superintendent of Police, Assistant Superintendent of Police and Inspector: Blue beret shall be of wool with black ribbon nylon head band and plastic board flap. The cap badge will be one Shapla with 3 jute leaves at the top surrounded by wheat and paddy wreath in silver embroidery.
- (iv) For Sub-Inspector, Town Sub Inspector and Sergeant: Plain or leather peak cap and blue beret of following description: Shapla surrounded by wheat and paddy wreath jointed by three jute leaves at the top, the word "Police" in Bengali shall be written below the lower joint of paddy and wheat wreath.

(v) Constable to Assistant Sub-Inspector including Assistant Sub-Inspector (Armed), Assistant Town Sub-Inspector and Naik: Beret blue is the headgear of Police personnel from the rank of Constable to Assistant Sub-Inspector including Assistant Sub-Inspector (Armed), Assistant Town Sub-Inspector and Naik. The badge will be made of brass metal of silver colour of the following description:

Shapla surrounded by wheat and paddy wreath jointed by three jute leaves at the top, the word "Police" in Bengali shall be written below the lower joint of paddy and wheat wreath.

- (c) Field Cap: Dark blue Field Cap of UN pattern may also be worn by all police personnel while on operational duty or in summer. But cap badges shall differ according to the rank as mentioned above.
- (2) Gorget Patch: Gorget patches are used with jackets of mess dress and tunic except miniature 2"×1" used on shirt which will have a single row of silver tracing braid. The different sizes of gorget patch used with buttons of appropriate size and pattern are as follows:—
 - (a) $2"\times 1" = \text{ on shirt }$
 - (b) $3\frac{1}{8}$ "× $1\frac{1}{8}$ " = on tunic and mess Dress (ceremonial dress)

Gorget patches are shaped to fit the collar and are worn at a distance of $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the fold of the collar.

- (i) Inspector General of Police and Additional Inspector General: A Silver Oak leaf embroidery and a metalic button of silver colour having Bangledesh Police Monogram at top end.
- (ii) Deputy Inspector General of Police, Additional Deputy Inspector General of Police and Superintendent of Police over 20 years qualifying service as class-I: A single row of silver tracing braid and a metalic button of silver colour having Bangladesh Police monogram at top end.

- (3) Belt: The Belt shall be as follows:—
 - (i) From Inspector of Police to Inspector General of Police: Black leather belt (1.5") with adjustable buckle having the monogram of cap badge of respective ranks.
 - (ii) For all other officers and ranks of all units of Bangladesh police except RAB: Web belt (1.7") black coloured Vel-cro system without eyelets.
 - (4) Rank badge: The Rank badge shall be as follows:—
 - (i) For Inspector-General of Police: Crossed sword and baton and one four pointed star and one Shapla of silver metal.
 - (ii) For Additional Inspector-General of Police: Crossed sword and baton with Shapla of silver metal.
 - (iii) For Deputy Inspector-General of Police: Shapla and three four pointed stars of silver metal.
 - (iv) Additional Deputy Inspector-General of Police and Superintendent of Police (over 20 years of service): Shapla and two four pointed stars of silver metal.
 - (v) Superintendent of Police: Shapla and one four pointed stars of silver metal.
 - (vi) Additional Superintendent of Police: One Shapla of silver metal.
 - (vii) Assistant Superintendent of Police (On successful completion of 1-year Basic Training in case of direct appointment and on confirmation of service in case of encadrement/ promotion of departmental Assistant Superintendent of Police): Three four pointed stars of silver metal.
 - (viii) Assistant Superintendent of Police (On appointment and promotion): Two four pointed stars of silver metal.
 - (ix) For Inspectors: One four pointed star of silver metal.
 - (x) For Sub-Inspector and Town sub Inspector (SI & TSI):

 Two four pointed (cross) metal flowers of silver colour. A
 dark blue ribbon of half-inch width on the base of the shoulder
 plate above the shoulder letters "Police" in bengali shall be
 engraved.

- (xi) For Sergeants: Same as sub-Inspectors noted above except the ribbon of red colour of same measurement.
- (xii) For Assistant Sub-Inspector (UB)/Assistant Sub-Inspector (AB)/ Assistant Town Sub-Inspector: Same as sub-Inspector but the number of flower is one.
- (xiii) Havilder Major: A cloth Shapla (silver embroidered on a red background) on the left forearm instead of Chevron, just above the wrist. Battalion Havilder Major will wear metal Shapla of silver colour.
- (xiv) For Naik: Scarlet colour Chevron with two worsted stripes on a dark blue cloth to be worn on the Shoulder. Chevron to be $2\frac{1}{2}$ across bars $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide interspaced $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch.
- (xv) For Constable: Shoulder letters "Police" in bengali made of metal of silver colour in the shoulder only. Shoulder letters "Police" in Bengali in silver metal is to be worn by the officers from the rank of Superintendent of Police down to the rank of Constable of all units of Bangladesh Police.
 - (4a) Embroidered badges of rank on the detachable epaulette may also be worn by the police personnel as mentioned in sub-rule 4(4) while in tactical exercise, training, riot-control, raid, search, winter Jacket and in peace keeping missions etc. The Rank badge shall be embroidered in silver colour thread.
- (5) Shirt: The shirt is to be made of (Pantone colour code:18-1306 TCX) Iron TC (Plain Fabrics) cloth. The front side of the shirt is open having six equidistant buttons and button holes (button holes include that of collar). The button hole puttie will be 1-5/8 inches wide and button catch puttie will be 1-1/2 inches wide. Breast pocket with pleats in centre, flap fastened in the centre, press studs on each corner of breast pocket flap, attached shoulder straps measuring to $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches to 2 inches wide according to the size of the

shirt at the base tapering to $1\frac{1}{3}$ inches at the button hole. The shirt shall be worn by Police personnel of all units who put on uniform

as working dress except APBn, SPBn and RAB.

- (a) For Summer Season: Shirt will be Half Sleeves;
- (b) For Winter Season: Shirt will be Full Sleeves.

- (6) Trousers- (Slacks): The trousers are to be made of (Pantone Colour Code- 19-3903 TCX) Coffee (Shale) TC twill fabric, featuring 2 waistband pleats maintaining 1.7" gap at the front in both sides (optional), single darts at the back (both side), five plain waistband loops, a hip pocket at the right back, and two side pockets. Two patch pockets parallel outside the thigh above the knee for ASI (AB), ASI (UB), ATSI, and below.
 - (i) Waist band and loops: The waist band shall be 1.4" wide. The length and width of the loop shall be 2.5" and 1" respectively.
 - (ii) Side Pockets: Two straight side pockets with an opening of 7 inches.
 - (iii) **Hip Pockets:** On the right back, one cut hip pocket with opening of 5" and 6" deep jetted to button through.

(iv) Hem:

- (a) Trouser's hem will be stitched by hand. The width of the bottom end will be 14"-16" all round. It shall be applicable to the police personnel of SI (UB) / TSI / Sergeants and above.
- (b) Hem shall be of army regulation pattern/ joggers with 1.4" elastic band with 3 (three) top stitches for officers of SI (AB), ASI (AB), ASI (UB), ATSI and below.
- (v) Buttons: Plain buttons of DTM (Dye To Match) colour.
- (7) Cardigan/ Jersey: The Cardigan/ Jersey shall be as follows:—
 - **For trainees:** Iron long sleeve jersey/ cardigan/ pullovers of Iron colour Shirt during winter season with two pockets and pointed flap with hole and button. Breast pockets to be 5" wide 7" deep in proportion.
- (8) Jackets: Iron coloured jacket to be used for keeping warm in cold weather having a front opening, Collar, lapels, sleeves and side pockets. The front side shall have zipper from below throat stretching below waist. Officers of subordinate ranks (sub inspector and below) shall use detachable hood.

- (9) Lanyard: Lanyard of deep blue colour with whistle be worn by police officers from Superintendent of Police to Inspector. Subordinate staff and other ranks (Sub-Inspectors, Assistant Sub-Inspectors (UB), Assistant Sub-Inspectors (AB), Assistant Town Sub-Inspectors, Naiks and Constables of Armed and Unarmed branch) to wear black lanyard with whistle. The lanyard should be put in the left breast pocket in the shortest routes.
- (10) Name Plate: All Police Officers including subordinate ranks will wear name plate above the right side of shirt's/ pullover's/ tunic's pocket:

A proper Bengali engraved plastic sheet with ceremonial dress (dark blue name plate as per APPENDIX-I). For working dress: A proper Bengali name embroidered on Vel-cro tape system, which will not exceed the width of the pocket of shirt as per APPENDIX-II. Officers serving in UN missions and attached to foreign dignitaries will wear similar nameplate (Vel-cro) in English.

(11) Baton/ Stick: The Additional Deputy Inspector-General of Police and above may use Batton or Stick of following description:—

Cane or wooden stick black polished, length 24", diameter $\frac{3}{4}$ " the inch at upper end gradually narrowing downwards up to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter having a silver metal band $(2\frac{1}{2})$ mounted at the broad end with a police monogram. The thin end will have 1" silver metal band.

Superintendent of Police down to Assistant Superintendent of Police may use black coshes having a length of 24".

(12) Boot for SI/ Armed SI/ TSI/ Sergeant to Constable: Black field, soft legs, stiffened to a depth of 4 to 6 inches from the top, laced at the instep, with 04 (Four) pairs of eyelet holes (minimum) and 05 (Five) pairs of hooks (minimum), black leather garters. Officers of and below the rank of ASI (UB), ASI (AB), ATSI will fold / tuck the lower portion of trouser.

Officers of and above the rank of SI (UB) / TSI/ Sergeant may use Boot DMS as per regulation pattern if necessary.

Jungle Boots: Jungle boots of matching uniform colour may be worn by the Armed Police Battalion personnel.

- (13) Shoes: Black Oxford style, plain toe with 5 eyelets for use with black socks to be worn by Sub-Inspector/ Sergeant /Town Sub Inspector and above of all units except APBn, SPBn, RAB and SI (AB). All Police personnel (Constable to Additional IGP) of SB and CID shall be entitled to use Black Oxford Shoe.
- (14) Canvas Shoe: Canvas shoes are to be worn by the police personnel from the rank of Constable to Inspector General for physical training, physical exercise and sports etc.
- (15) Gumboots: During rainy season, all officers are entitled to use gumboot as and when necessary.
- (16) Medals: The Medals shall be as follows:—
 - (i) The ribbon will be one and three-quarter inches in length unless class necessitate its being longer. When two or more medals are worn they will be so arranged that the lower edges or the lowest point of the medal are in line. The length of all ribbons will be regulated be that of the medal which, including any class, is the longest. The bar from which decorations of medals are suspended will be placed immediately above the left breast pocket of the jacket. If only a single medal is worn this will be placed with the inner edge of the ribbon one inch from the inner seam of the pocket flap. With two or more medals the inner seam of the pocket flap. When the decorations and medals cannot, on account of their number, be suspended from the bar so as to be fully seen, they are to overlap.
 - (ii) Miniature medals will be worn with mess dress on the left breast in one horizontal line one inch below the point of the shoulder, suspended from a bar of which no part is to be seen. The length of the bar must vary with the number of miniatures, but in no case should it project beyond the lapel or shoulder seam of the jacket. The top of the collar badge should be 3/4 the inch beneath the lower edge of the medal.

When the miniatures cannot, on account of their number, be suspended from the bar as to be fully seen they are to overlap.

(17) **Ribbon:** In undress uniform of informal working dress, the ribbon will be $1\frac{3}{4}$ " inch in length and will be worn on a bar or sewn on the

jacket, without intervals, immediately above the left breast of the jacket or shirt. When there is no sufficient room to wear the ribbons in one row, they will be worn in two or more rows not more than $\frac{1}{2}$ inch

apart the center of the rows to be immediately above the button of the left pocket. Generally four different ribbons will make one row.

- **5.** Ceremonial dress: The ceremonial dress shall be as follows:—
 - (1) Head Dress: Peak cap of the description noted in rule 4. It should be worn by officers of the rank of Sergeant/Sub-Inspector and above. Others (Below Sub-Inspector and Sergeants) will wear beret caps of the description mentioned in the same rule.
 - (2) Tunic: (a) Tunic to be worn by officers of the rank of inspector and above on ceremonial occasions.

The Winter Tunic will be of following description:—

Dark blue Fabric single breasted, cut a lounge coat of the waist, loose at chest and shoulders but fitted at the waist. Military skirt to bottom edge. A silver-plated hood on each side at the waist. Collar to be cut as in an ordinary civilian lounge coat. Two cross patch breast pockets above $6\frac{1}{2}$ " inches wide and $7\frac{1}{4}$ " inches deep to the top of the flap, with

a $2\frac{1}{4}$ " inches box plate in the centre fastened at the top with a small

Bangladesh Police pattern botton, flap with button hole, the cover pockets $2\frac{1}{4}$ " inches deep and $6\frac{1}{2}$ " inches wide. Two expanding

pockets below the waist (plates at the sides) $9\frac{1}{4}$ " inches wide at the top $10\frac{1}{2}$ " inches at the bottom. $8\frac{1}{4}$ " inches deep to the top of the pocket, fastened at the top with a small Police pattern button, flap with button hole, to cover pockets $3\frac{1}{4}$ " inches deep and $10\frac{1}{2}$ " inches wider, the top of the pocket to be tacked down at the corner in such a manner that the pocket can be expanded at the top also if necessary. Four medium Police pattern button down the front. Pointed cuffs, 5" inches height at the point and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " inches behind. Shoulder straps of the same material

as garment fasted with a small Police pattern button. Shoulder title "Police" will be worn by S.P. and below.

The tunic is to be worn with a white colour shirt and dark blue tie.

- (b) Summer tunic: On ceremonial occasions during the hot weather the wearing of Khaki drill/synthetic tunic of bush-shirt of regulation pattern and trouser of similar material to be worn instead of the tunic mentioned in rule 5(2) (a): Provided that the Officers may use summer tunic in office.
- (3) **Trouser**: Matching trouser of the same material of regulation pattern [As mentioned in rule 4(6).]
- (4) Rank badge: Rank badges, gorget patches and medals will be worn according to Rank and entitlement.
- (5) Shoes: Officers will put on shoes with black socks mentioned in rule 4(13).
- (6) Aiguillettes: (i) Aiguillettes of silver colour with winter tunic and that of golden colour with summer tunic shall be worn by the Additional Superintendent of Police to Inspector General of Police.
 - (ii) Inspector General of Police shall wear Aiguillettes on the right breast pocket of the tunic while other officers will wear on the left breast pocket of the tunic.

6. Mess Dress : The Mess Dress shall be as follows :—

Mess dress shall be worn at official public entertainments by night or when an officer is invited to meet the Head of the State, Head of the Government or The Inspector General of Police at dinner or at an official function by night unless full dress is specially ordered and when dinning at Military, Naval or Air-force messes. Dark lounge suit with service tie may also be worn on special occasions.

(1) Jacket: White Fabric with golden epaulette total length of shoulder is 6" (without shoulder measurement of epaulette shoulder) where base is 1.5" /1.1" Detachable shoulder strap with golden epaulette and silver-blue-silver pattern with miniature rank badges without title shoulder letter. Miniature medals and decorations to be worn on the left side above left breast pocket. The jacket is tie collar when length of the collar is 2³/₄". The Jacket is open in the front having 10 silver metal buttons. Each button is studded in police monogram. Main buttons are 05, show buttons are 05. Size of the

cuff is 2.5 /10". Lace around the cuff is blue and silver 1.1" width. Shade is Blue- Silver- Blue Pattern. A Plate with silver lace is to be attached from collar up to bottom in the outer edge of the Front placket. Chest pocket should be on upper right and left side of the chest measuring 5.5" in length, 4.75" in width, including 1.25" (in width) fold at the middle having V shaped flap measuring 2.6" in length. At the middle of the flap there shall be button hole in each flap having buttons studded in Bangladesh Police monogram. Two pockets below the waist in both sides of the placket shall be show pockets measuring 2.6" in length and 6.1" in width.

- (2) Trousers: Dark blue two sides straight pocket with one hip pocket at the right back featuring 2 waistband pleats maintaining 1.7" gap at the front (both sides), single darts at the back (both sides), five plain waistband loops. The bottom hem is $1\frac{3}{4}$ ". The hem will be stitched by hand. The wide of the bottom is 14"-16".
- (3) Full Sleeve Cotton vest V-Shaped shall be worn under the jacket in winter season.
- (4) Shoe: Shoe oxford styles plain toe with 5 eyelets with black socks.
- (5) Head dress: Side cap Police blue colour with golden colour piping of appropriate pattern with an embroidered cap badge on the left side.
- (6) Mess Dress Epaulette: Epaulette with golden colour which length is 05", width is 2/1.25" for Superintendent of police over 20 years of service and above. Epaulette with silver borders, Silver-blue-silver pattern which length is 05" width is 2/1.25" for Inspector to superintendent of police (in case of Superintendent of police below 20 years of service).
- (7) Mess Dress Aiguillettes: Aiguillettes of golden colour, similar to that of summer tunic, Shall be worn by superintendent of police over 20 years of service and above. Aiguillettes of mixture of silver-blue colour shall be worn by Additional superintendent of police to superintendent of police below 20 years of service. Inspector General of Police shall wear Aiguillettes on the right breast pocket of the mess dress (Mess kit) and others in the left breast pocket.

- 7. Uniform of other police personnel: The Uniform of other police personnel shall be as follows:—
 - (1) Uniform of Mounted Police: The officers and personnel of mounted police are to wear breeches made of deep-blue drill white anklet web, besides other articles of uniform on ceremonial occasions:
 - (a) Jacket: Red Polyester jacket with close neck (black with jory) without pocket two sides open at the back blue colour shoulder straps measuring $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to 2" width $\frac{1}{2}$ " jory all side.
 - **(b) Breeches:** White tetron trouser with two sides pocket.
 - **(c) Boot:** Long black boot will be worn over the breeches.
 - (d) Head dress: Blue colour Pagri over jory kolla (golden colour) having one red and golden jhalar falling on the right side.
 - (e) Belt: Web belt moulded with white rexin.
 - (f) Sashes: White sashes with $1\frac{1}{2}$ " width blue piping at the centre and red jhalar at the end of sashes.
 - **(g) Shoulder:** Decorated black shoulder with golden jory stripes and golden jhalar. In addition white hand gloves will be worn during ceremonial occasion.
 - (2) Uniform for Women Police: The Uniform for women police shall be as follows—
 - (a) District and metropolitan Police and all other units except APBn, SPBn, SB, CID and RAB: The trousers are to be made of Coffee (Shale) TC Twill cloth with half shirt of Iron TC (Plain Fabrics) cloth with 4 pockets on the front side. The front side of the shirt is open having seven equidistant buttons and button holes (button holes include that of collar). Coffee (Shale) saree may be worn with Iron colour blouse. In addition, the women police willing to wear head cover or working at traffic unit may put on full sleeve shirt or blouse throughout the year.

Provided that the woman Police, during pregnancy, may wear plain clothes with the prior approval of the concerned head of unit.

- (a) For Summer Season: Shirt will be Half Sleeves
- (b) For Winter Season: Shirt will be Full Sleeves.
- **(b) Head Dress:** Side cap of dark blue with silver piping and authorized cap badges shall be worn as mentioned in rule 4(1);

(c) Head Cover:

- (i) Head cover shall be authorized Coffee (Shale);
- (ii) For the Rapid Action Battalion, head cover shall be authorized colour;
- (iii) Head cover with the ceremonial dress shall be of the authorized colour;
- (iv) Head cover shall be tucked inside the collar of the uniform shirt or blouse or ceremonial dress and it shall not cover the name plate, ribbon and rank badge; and
- (v) The woman police wearing head cover shall put on the authorized cap of the respective working unit as and when required.
 - Provided that the police willing to wear head cover shall take prior approval of the concerned head of unit.
- (d) Belt: Web belt black (1.75) coloured Vel-Cro system without eyelets for subordinate police and as mentioned in rule 4(3).
- (e) Boots: Boot DMS with 04 (Four) pairs of eyelet holes and 05 (Five) pairs of hooks and Pump shoe as per regulation pattern and as mentioned in rule 4(12);
- **(f) Shoes:** Black Oxford style, plain toe with 5 eyelets used with black socks to be worn by all officers of and above the rank of SI (UB) and Canvas shoes as mentioned in rule 4(13 and 14).

(3) Uniform for Traffic Police:

- (a) The Uniform for Traffic Police shall be as follows:—
 - (i) Iron Colour TC (full shirt)

- (ii) Coffee (Shale) TC (full pant)
- (iii) Plain Patent white colour peak-cap with a reflecting band between two lower welts shall be worn.
- (iv) Extra white sleeves with concerned unit sign.
- (v) Boots: black leather DMS with 04 (Four) pairs of eyelet holes (minimum) and 05 (Five) pairs of hooks (minimum) for officers of ATSI and below.
- (vi) White web belt single strap shoulder.
- **(b)** Uniform for Woman Traffic Police: The Uniform for Woman Police shall be as follows:—
 - (i) Iron Colour TC (full shirt)
 - (ii) Coffee (Shale) TC (full pant)
 - (iii) Boots: DMS Boots with 04 (Four) pairs of eyelet holes (minimum) and 05 (Five) pairs of hooks (minimum).
 - (iv) Hat: Dark-blue colours with 2 inches band of white and dark blue colour.
- **(c) Gumboot:** During rainy season the traffic police personnel may wear gumboot of regulation pattern.
- (4) Uniform for Armed Police Battalion and Special Security and Protection Battalion: The Uniform for Armed Police Battalion (APBn) and Special Security and Protection Battalion (SPBn) shall be as follows:—
 - (i) The pocket of the uniform shirt shall be of V shape.
 - (ii) Male police personnel shall have 02 pockets on the upper front of their shirts and no pocket on the front lower side. But female police personnel shall have a total of 04 pockets- 02 on upper front and 02 on the lower front side.
 - (iii) The buttons of the shirt shall be covered.
 - (iv) The shirt shall have a collar.
 - (v) There shall be Elastic on both sides of the waist of the shirt.

- (vi) There shall be a pen pocket on the upper part of the right sleeve.
- (vii) The sleeves shall have cuffs.
- (viii) For visibility from a distance, there shall be maroon fabric Plate (the colour of the police cap) underneath the rank badge.
- (ix) There shall be the word "Police" written in metallic letters on both shoulders of the shirt.
- (x) For APBn the bottom of the Pants shall have 1.25-2.5 inch belt with chain and elastic and for SPBn the pants shall have a chain and a 2.75 inch long velcro with elastic at the bottom.
- (xi) There shall be two according pockets (with V-Shape flap covers for APBn and rectangular flap covers for SPBn) on both sides of the pants.
- (xii) There shall be a pocket on the right side at the back of the pants, and it shall not have a cover/ flap.
- (xiii) The width of the belt of the pants shall be 1.5 inches and the side pockets shall be straight.
- (xiv) Officers of and above the rank of Inspector shall not wear belts. However, they must wear belts/ tactical belts during parade/ operational activities. Officers of and below the rank of Sub Inspector shall wear a black-coloured waist belt (web belt).
- (xv) The maroon beret cap shall be used with cap badge according to the rank.
- (xvi) Field cap shall be made from the fabric of the uniform. The design of the cap shall vary based on the ranks.
- (xvii) Black boots of approved design of Bangladesh Police shall be worn.
- (xviii) According to the Instructions of Police Headquarters, in winter season, full-sleeve shirts shall be worn and in the summer season, half-sleeve shirts with folded borders shall be worn.
- (xix) The entire uniform shall be double-stitched.
- (xx) The cold weather Jacket of same combat fabric shall be worn with a detachable hood.

(5) Unit sign $(2\frac{1}{2}"$ diameter):

- (a) Unit signs which were partially designed according to Bangladesh Police monogram as mentioned in Police Dress Rules, 2004, shall be redesigned considering Bangladesh Police Monogram as mentioned in Rule 3 of Police Dress Rules, 2025.
- (b) Bangladesh Police Monogram will be worn on the right arm of shirt/cardigan/jersey/ jacket/ tunic etc.
- (c) Police Personnel of Police Academy/ PTCs, Range, Metropolitan Police, APBn and all other units shall put on respective unit signs on the left arm of shirt/cardigan/jersey/jacket/tunic etc.
- (d) Officers serving UN will use Patch with National Flag. The word 'Bangladesh Police' in English will be written below the National Flag.
- (e) A metal Golden badge engraving Police monogram Shall be attached on the right side of the chest. "Bangladesh Police" shall be engraved in the upper/lower part.
- (6) Dress for Stick Orderly: Web-belt with nickle runner and moulded with white rexin anklet canvas white, orderly stick black with metal chain and Academy/Police monogram orderly cross belt with shapla, whistle and metal covered toshdan and chain, white hand gloves and blue beret cap.
- (7) **Dress for colour Party:** Web belt with nickle runner moulded with white rexin anklet, white canvas, cross, belt moulded with white rexin having arrangement for flag carrying $(2\frac{3}{4}"$ nickled buckle) white hand gloves and beret cap.
- (8) Dress for Band Party: Every Range including Railway Police/APBN/ Metropolitan Police/Police Academy, PTCs and others may have separate traditional Police Bands of their own.
- (9) Dress for Rapid Action Battalion (RAB): The Dress for Rapid Action Battalion dress shall be as follows:—
 - (a) Cap: Beret black or Combat cap having authorized cap badges.
 - **(b) Shirt & Trouser :** Half sleeve shirt and trouser to be made of black TC drill cloth as mentioned in rule 5 & 6. In hot weather or for operational purpose black round collar half T shirt may be worn instead of black half shirt.

- (c) Belt: Web black belt having Vel-cro system without eyelets.
- **(d) Shoes**: Boot DMS with 9 eyelets (Regulation pattern) authorized combat type boot may be worn with black socks.
- (e) Jacket: Black long sleeve Jersey/Pullover during winter season with two pockets and pointed flap with hole and button. Breast pockets to be of 5" wide and 7" deep in proportion.
- **(f) Rank Badge:** Rank Badges to be worn on shoulder as per authorization.
- (g) Name Plate: Name plate (Vel-cro system) in brown colour to be worn by all members of the RAB as mentioned in rule 3(10).
- (h) Unit Sign: Approved unit sign of RAB $(2\frac{1}{2})$ diameter) will be worn by all ranks on the left arm over the Shirt or Jersey.
- (10) Dress for immigration Police: Immigration Police on duty at the entry points will wear the uniform of coffee (Shale) pant with Iron coloured shirt as mentioned in rule 4(5) and 4 (6) with the unit sign of Special branch with the inscription "Immigration" written at the bottom of the insignia.

(11) Special Action Team of Bangladesh Police will wear the following:

- (i) Metropolitan Police Special Action Team will wear dark navy colour shirt/Polo Shirt, Khaki colour cargo pants, khaki caps and desert colour commando boots.
- (ii) Anti Terrorism Unit Special Action Team will wear dark navy colour shirt/polo Shirt, Khaki colour cargo pants, Khaki caps and desert colour commando boots.
- (iii) Armed Police Battalion Special Action Team will wear maroon colour shirt/Polo Shirt, Khaki colour cargo pants, Khaki caps and desert colour commando boots.
- **8.** Repeal and Savings: (1) The Police Dress Rules, 2004, is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken or any order made under the said Rules shall be deemed to have been done, taken or made, as the case may be, under the corresponding provision of this Rules.
