It is required of the holder of this licence as a condition of its remaining in force that he shall duly and faithfully abide by following conditions and by the provisions of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909, as subsequently amended by all notifications and rules which have been or which may from time to time be made or published thereunder (as far as they are applicable to this licence):—

1. That he shall pay to Government an annual lump fee of Rs.100 only.
2. That he shall furnish a security bond of Rs. being equivalent to the differences of duty between the usual rate and the concessional rate on the quantity of rectified spirit he is permitted to store at a time. 4. That a sample of each batch of preparation shall be picked up by an Excise Officer not below the rank of Sub-Inspector and sealed with his official seal and sent through an agent of the licensee to the Chemical Examiner or the Assistant Chemical Examiner to the Government of Bangladesh for analysis as to its alcoholic strength and standard of quality.
5. That no issue or sale shall be made of any preparation which is found by the Chemical Examiner or the Assistant Chemical Examiner not to be of the standard quality.
6. That every preparation shall have a distinct batch number and that there will be a running serial for each preparation for the whole year. Every phial of preparation shall have a label attached to it containing the batch number, the name and addresses of the manufacturer, the percentage of alcohol of the preparation, the name of the preparation, etc.
7. That manufacture shall be carried on under the supervision of a qualified Chemist who shall be a B.Sc. in Chemistry or Pharmacology of any recognised University in Bangladesh.
8. That Mother Tinctures of Dangerous Drugs, such as Opium, Cannabis, etc., shall not be manufactured except under a separate licence or licences under the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1930 or rules made thereunder.
9. That issue of Mother Tinctures of Dangerous Drugs shall not be made except in Homeopathic dilutions, the strength of such dilution being fixed by the Director of Taxation and Excise with the recommendation of the Chemical Examiner or the Assistant Chemical Examiner to the Government of Bangladesh.
10. That the licensee shall not use the spirit obtained at the concessional rate of duty for any purpose than that for which it is intended.
11. That he shall submit, every time for a supply of rectified spirit a written requisition showing the balance in hand to the Superintendent of Excise along with the duplicate licence and obtain in his sanction for supply on the body of the duplicate licence in the space provided for the purpose.
12. That he shall take supply of spirit under cover of a pass issued and an house, as the case may be, on the body of the duplicate licence in the space provided for the purpose.
13. That he shall store spirit so obtained in casks, vats or other receptacles which shall be kept in a secure place under a special lock and key of the licensee or his manager approved by the Deputy Commissioner.
14. That he shall keep a regular and correct account of such spirit and of tinctures manufactured with the same and submit a statement to the Deputy Commissioner at the end of each month in the form prescribed by the Director of Taxation and Excise.
15. That he shall maintain a register showing the names and addresses of purchasers with the name and the quantity of each preparation sold to each such purchaser and issue and preserve cash memos showing such sales. Such sales shall be made to Homeopaths and Homeopathic firms only.

16. That he shall at all times during which his business premises remains open or on demand allow and give facilities to an Excise Officer not below the rank of Sub-Inspector to inspect his licence and his premises and render him every assistance in taking stock, examination of accounts and records, the gauging and proving of spirit or taking samples, if any, as may be required by him.

17. That he shall carry on manufacture of Homeo mother tinctures under proper sanitary condition.

18. That a licence for the storage of rectified spirit for the manufacture of Homeopathic Mother Tinctures may be issued only to an experienced Homeopathic practitioner or a Homeopathic firm of sufficient standing.

19. That the laboratory shall be housed in a suitable building and the laboratory shall be equipped with necessary instruments and apparatus for the purpose of manufactures of Homeo-Mother-Tinctures.

20. That every application for a licence for storage of rectified spirit for the manufactures of Homeo-Mother-Tinctures shall be forwarded by the District Excise authority with necessary recommendations to the Director of Taxation and Excise for his approval. If the Director considers that it is a fit case for issue of such a licence he will communicate his approval to the Deputy Commissioner of the district for the issue of such a licence. The Deputy Commissioner shall then issue a licence on furnishing a security bond by the licensee as referred under condition 2.
