No. MF/IU-12/72 Pt.I/381—6th July 1972—In exercise of the power conferred by Article 8 of the Bangladesh Nationalised and Private Organisation (Regulation of Salary of Employees) Order, 1972 (President's Order No. 54 of 1972), the Government of Bangladesh is pleased to direct as follows:—

- (1) The unpaid amount of salary of an employee shall be utilised by investment in Bangladesh Savings Certificates.
- (2) If the unpaid amount of salary is not a multiple of Taka 5, the amount remaining uninvested shall be carried over to the next month when this amount shall be added to the unpaid amount of remuneration of that month and invested in the manner as provided in this Order.
- (3) Every employer shall purchase each month Savings Certificate for the unpaid amount of salary and shall not hand over the unpaid amount to the employee. When purchased, the Certificates shall be retained by the Employer and shall ultimately be disposed of in such manner as the Government directs.
- (4) The accumulated unpaid amount of salary for the month of May and June, 1972 shall be utilised by investment in Bangladesh Savings Certificates in the manner as provided in this Order.
- (5) The Savings Certificates issued in lieu of the unpaid amount of salary shall bear the same rate of interest as was admissible on Defence Savings Certificates on the 15th December, 1971.
- (6) If on any occasion the Bank or Post Office runs short of Savings Certificates, it will issue a Provisional Receipt. Savings Certificates will be issued as soon as they are available on production of the Provisional Receipt. The date of issue of the Provisional Receipt shall be shown as the date of issue of the Savings Certificate for the purpose of maturity and calculation of interest.
- (7) The Savings Certificates held by the employer under this Order shall, subject to paragraph 3 above, not be encashable before the expiry of two years and shall be encased with the words "Not encashable before the expiry of two years from the date of issue" with rubber stamp or red ink by the issuing authority.
- (8) Every employer shall submit a monthly return not later than the 15th of each month to the Director of National Savings, Dacca, in the Form given in the schedule to this Order showing the amount invested. The Director of National Savings or any officer duly authorised by him shall have access to the accounts of any establishment for verification of investments and the employer concerned shall produce for inspection to the Director or such officer all the registers, books of accounts, pay rolls and any other relevant documents that may be required for such verification:
