- (b) to arrange for training of cotton cultivators and establishment of demonstration plots;
- (c) to encourage development of ginnery for processing the cultivators' produce of seed cotton;
- (d) to render assistance in the marketing of seed cotton at growers' level.

4. The Executive Director will be responsible for the day-to-day functioning of the Board and implementation of its development schemes and projects subject to the general supervision, control and policy directives of the Board.

5. The finance of the Board will consist of funds provided under development projects and such other funds as may be made available by Government.

6. The Board, may, subject to the approval of the Government appoint such officers, advisers and other employees as may be necessary, for the efficient performance of the functions of the Board, and such officers, advisers and employees shall be deemed to be Government servants.

7. The Board shall subject to the approval of the Government make regulations for conduct of its business.
