"52. The Ansars may form Associations with the prior approval of the Government and subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) Membership of an Ansar Association shall be limited strictly within the members of the Ansars Organization and no outsider shall be allowed to be a member of or office bearer in such Associations.
- (b) The office bearers and members of the Association shall not participate in the activities of the Association at the time they are employed in any official duty.

(c) The Association may take up the question of their welfare generally and will not interest itself in individual cases of its members.

(d) No rule or law and bye-law of an Association shall be valid until it has received the approval of Government, and the Government may at any time require any modification to be made thereto.

(e) The Government may call for their own information copies of rules, laws and bye-laws of an Association, the annual statements of its accounts and the list of its members or such other information as may be required.

(f) The Association shall be a non-political body and shall not concern itself with political matters nor will it have any connection, directly or indirectly, with any political party or organisation and shall not indulge in activities subversive of the State, established authority or discipline."
